The 3rd **EPRI Telecommunications Initiative Advisory Meeting** was held April 4 and 5 in New York City. Many thanks to Con Edison for being our host.



During the meeting, members received an update <u>project status and schedule, reviewed milestones</u>, and discussed future plans and priorities for a new Telecom Project Set 161G in 2018. During the two days of meetings presentations and updates were given by EPRI staff, utility members, and invited speakers covering seven topics:

Serial-to-Packet, Private Wireless, Commercial Cellular and Shared Networks, Strategic Fiber, Connectivity at the Edge of the Grid, Network Management and Reliability Metrics, and Telecom Roadmap and Planning Framework.

There were also optional tours of the Verizon Network Operations Center in New Jersey and the Consolidated Edison Learning Center.

The next EPRI Telecommunications Initiative Advisory Meeting will be October 3 and 4, 2017, in Akron, Ohio, and will be sponsored by FirstEnergy.

Cyber Security Birds of a Feather Workshop

The second annual **Cyber Security** *Birds of a Feather* **Workshop** was held April 4 and 5, at SCANA Corporation in Columbia, South Carolina. This one-and-a-half-day workshop focused on cyber threat management and incident response and was attended by folks from several utilities that are members of the EPRI Cyber Security Program (Program 183).

Day One included an intriguing, in-depth tour of the SCANA Integrated Security Operations Center (ISOC) and forensics lab, along with a discussion session led by Andy Bowden, SCANA director of Cyber Security, covering details of the programs and processes utilized in the ISOC. Additionally, EPRI moderated sessions with panelists from member utilities on the topics of cyber threat hunting and cyber forensics.

On day 2, personnel from Sierra Nevada Corporation provided a demonstration of its Binary Armor product which is part of the incident response test bed in the EPRI Cyber Security Research Lab. Also, Steve Sanders, principal cyber security architect from Southern Company, provided an update on the implementation of the solution that was



tested in the EPRI lab as part of the Integrated Threat Analysis Framework (ITAF) project.

The workshop resulted in significant collaboration among members of the program and meaningful technology transfer opportunities. EPRI would like to thank Andy Bowden and Robert McKie from SCANA for hosting the event and providing excellent insight into its cyber security program.
